Dear Gentlemen:

As you know, Exhibit 5 to USADA’s Motion to Dismiss in this matter (Court Docket No. 33) is the Affidavit of Shawn O. Farrell. Mr. Farrell’s Affidavit references Exhibits A through G – international license application forms used by USA Cycling in the years 2003 – 2005 and 2008 – 2011. These are identical to Exhibits J through P to the Affidavit of Molly Tomlonovic (Exhibit 4 to USADA’s Motion to Dismiss).

The remainder of the exhibits noted in Mr. Farrell’s Affidavit refer to USA Cycling’s Rules for the period 1998 – 2011, with the exception of USA Cycling’s Rules for 1999. Exhibits Q through X to the Affidavit of Molly Tomlonovic are excerpts from USA Cycling’s Rules for the periods 2001 – 2005 and 2008 – 2010. The complete rule sets for 1998, 2000 – 2005 and 2009 – 2011 would total nearly two thousand pages and attaching these as exhibits to Mr. Farrell’s Affidavit would render it unwieldy. Accordingly, USADA elected not to file with the court any of the exhibits referenced in Mr. Farrell’s affidavit. As a courtesy to you, I wanted to provide access to the complete rule sets USADA has received from USA Cycling through a secure file sharing service.
