We apologize for the fact that Monday is a holiday in New Zealand, but it looks like Mr. Hamman will require your assistance beginning Monday afternoon at approximately 1:00pm.

Attached find:

- 1) A copy of Chapter 4 Culture and Dependency, as translated by John Bandy, SCA Promotions in-house counsel, from the original French work *L.A. Confidentiel* by David Walsh and Pierre Ballester.
- 2) Selections from an English translation of *LA Confidentiel* provided by the author, David Walsh.

Please review these materials with the realization that they are the underpinnings for the interview of Stephen Swart by SCA. The translations naturally are duplicative since they translate much of the same material.
